# Faith Community Nursing Course

Spring Semester January 13 through April 15, 2018

**EQUIPPING NURSES FOR HEALTH MINISTRY** 

### What is Faith Community Nursing?

A Faith Community Nurse works with the congregation to establish and sustain a health ministry program. Faith Community Nursing is a specialty professional nursing practice recognized by the American Nurses Association.

A Faith Community Nurse (FCN) may serve as a paid or unpaid member of the church staff. FCNs serve within a faith community to help meet the mental, emotional, physical, social and spiritual needs of parishioners and others in the larger community.

FCNs provide care with a focus on intentional care of the spirit. The FCN uses evidence based interventions such as: education, counseling, advocacy, referral, and accessing community resources. They also work collaboratively with other partners to provide health/wellness promotion, disease prevention, and holistic care of individuals, families, and communities.

#### Pilot Program

The Foundations of Faith Community Nursing (TFFCN) is a certificate course and CEUs for nurses with an active RN license. Class size is limited to 12 participants and has been developed using the curriculum of the International Parish Nurse Resource Center (IPNRC) Westberg Institute.\*

Holy Spirit Episcopal Church, Waco in collaboration with The Episcopal Diocese of Texas and Seminary of the Southwest has partnered as an affiliate of the IPNRC Westberg Institute. The Westberg Institute is an approved provider of continuing nursing education by the Tennessee Nurses Association, an accredited approver by the American Nurses Credentialing Center's Commission on Accreditation.

Partial funding for the course is provided by The Episcopal Health Foundation.

#### When/Where

The course is taught over a four-month semester. It includes: an initial retreat style weekend, including overnight accommodations at The Seminary of the Southwest in Austin, TX; followed by ten online (ZOOM) sessions once a week on Tuesday evenings 6:30 to 8:30 p.m.; concluding with another retreat style weekend at The Seminary of the Southwest in Austin.
