In your group, read the passage three (3) times. Before each reading, read the accompanying question below. After each reading, share with the group your answer to the question.

1 Corinthians 12:4-11

New Revised Standard Version

⁴ Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; ⁵ and there are varieties of services, but the same Lord; ⁶ and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who activates all of them in everyone. ⁷ To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. ⁸ To one is given through the Spirit the utterance of wisdom, and to another the utterance of knowledge according to the same Spirit, ⁹ to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, ¹⁰ to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another the discernment of spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. ¹¹ All these are activated by one and the same Spirit, who allots to each one individually just as the Spirit chooses.

Ouestions:

1st **reading:** What word, phrase, or image draws your attention in this passage? Share your answer with your group.

2nd **reading:** What does this passage teach you about your gifts and the gifts of your church community? Share your answer with your group.

3rd **reading:** What is God inviting you to do, be, or change through this passage? Share your answer with your group.

As a whole group: Is there a theme that connects the reflections on this passage by the members of your group?
