**DISCUSSION POINTS FOR THE CHECK-OUT DESPEDIDA
WITH THE FAMILY AND APODERADO(S)**

1. Family plan when the need arises. How to contact each other, as need be (parents, apoderado/a, and kids immediately
 - a. Everyone has each other's phone numbers on hand and ready to use
 - b. Kids know what to do and how to contact apoderado/a (index cards and phones)
 - c. Apoderado/a and family know where POA is located at house
 - d. Fill in and hand out index card with POA designee's name, phone, and address for kids to carry in backpacks, etc.
 - e. Program respective phone numbers into people's phones, especially kids' phones
2. Make sure there are multiple signatories on bank accounts
3. Secure and carry a debit card to carry in case deported: one for each parent or kid, or even apoderado(a). This will facilitate access to money if needed
4. Explain how warrants work (the difference between a federal judge's warrant and a fake ICE administrative warrant). Attached. Give them a copy.
 - a. Explain right to refuse to open the door without showing a judicial warrant through the window or shoving it under the door
5. People can make copies of the POA. A copy has the same validity.
 - a. Leave a copy with the kids' school
 - b. Ask if they want extra copies of executed document(s) from us and, if so, give them
6. Give Henna car-check certificate and explain it
7. Give copies of other know-your-rights information
8. Make sure POAs are in envelopes and label the envelopes
9. Get permission to text American Gateways videos [and follow up to do it, if yes]
