Sometimes life leads us into decisions we never expected. Moments where our plans shift, our path changes, and the future feels uncertain. In those moments, the only thing that has carried me is faith.

Faith reminds me that even when life takes a turn I did not anticipate, God is still present, still guiding, still opening a way where I cannot see one. When circumstances feel heavy or confusing, I hold on to this truth: God never abandons us, even when the journey looks different from what we imagined.

Pray often and never lose your faith. That is what I would tell anyone experiencing a painful reality. Faith is what has carried me through every storm. No matter what I've faced, good or bad, I have always believed that everything is possible in God's eyes.

Many people tremble in their faith or question God's actions, but I don't. I have seen God's hand at work throughout my life, especially during my journey. By praying and surrendering my worries to Him, He guided me in ways I never expected.

On my journey, I once approached an immigration officer for help. Those traveling with me warned me not to speak, but my faith was stronger than my fear. That officer helped me and gave me what I needed to continue. From that moment, I learned that God can use strangers, those who may seem like enemies, or even those we least expect, to bless us.

During difficult times, I turn to prayer and to the Psalms. I am grateful for those who prayed with me when I needed it most. Through their prayers, I felt God's presence and perfect timing.

Faith has always been my foundation. In moments of hardship, the easiest thing to lose is faith, but for me, it was the only thing I had left.
